Flash Cards



- Question or key term on one side
- Answer or definition on the other
- Keep information as short as possible
- Write clearly- you should be able to read what you have written at a very quick glance
- Use different coloured card or pens for different subject /topics
- Review them regularly









- Use a key image to represent the topic at the centre
- Use large branches for the main topics and smaller branches for sub-topics
- Use different colours for branches
- Use lots of images to trigger your memory
- Use key words and phrases don't write too much



Don't just copy sentences – use your own words!



- Choose a topic or part topic (not too large)
- Write out key words, phrases, diagrams, quotes etc that trigger your memory.
- Pick out key diagrams, quotes etc.
- Re-read your notes and check they makes sense and contain key information.
- Make sure you use your own word don't just copy
- Re-write them again further summarising.
