

## Year 11 Examination Preparation Programme Student Information Sheet 2022

The next few weeks are the most important few weeks of your school so far.

We have put this booklet together to support your preparations for all of the examinations during the next few weeks.

The week by week timetable in the Exam Period Preparation Programme contains information relating to your normal timetabled lessons, dates of each of your examinations, booster sessions and exam revision sessions.

# How to Use the Exam Preparation Programme

It is expected that you will be in school for all lessons and attending normal timetabled lessons until 2.55pm on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> June.

The only times that you **do not** follow your normal timetable is if you have any of the following;

- An examination
- A Booster session
- An Exam Revision session

## Last Day & Leavers' Assembly – Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June

If you have a Spanish exam you should arrive at school for 7.55am to attend the Booster session in E1. You will then have your Spanish writing exam. After your exam you may stay in school to revise, in the Library, or go home prior to returning later in the day for the Leaver's Assembly.

All other students should arrive in school no earlier than 1:15pm, via Chatsworth Road, to attend the Leavers' Assembly.

You must be in **full school uniform**. If you arrive without school uniform on you will not be allowed in school.

The assembly will finish around 2:15pm, after which you will leave school for the remainder of the day.

## Week Commencing 20th June

You should continue to attend the Booster and Revision sessions timetabled (Science, Music, Hospitality & Catering and Further Maths).

- For the afternoon Booster sessions please arrive at school no earlier than 11:00am via Chatsworth Road.
- For the Physics Revision session please arrive at school no earlier than 1:45pm, via Chatsworth Road.

If you do not have an examination, Revision or a Booster session you need to do independent revision at home. You are still welcome to attend any normal timetabled lessons in subjects that you still have exams in. Please sign in and out at reception.

Your attendance to Booster Sessions and Revision Sessions is compulsory.

## What if I have a timetabled lesson in a subject, but I have taken all the exams in this subject?

There will be times when you are attending a lesson in a subject when the exams for that subject are all finished. You are expected to bring revision with you to school every day, so that in these lessons you can revise in a structured and supported environment.

# Why, if I have an exam in the afternoon, do I need to go to my lessons in the morning?

We have planned for each exam to have a Booster Session immediately prior to the exam to ensure you are fully prepared for your exam. As we have had a disrupted two years, it is crucial that all lessons are attended in all subjects.






#### Exam Period Programme

The main examination period covers a 5 week block, starting Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May and continuing until Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June, although students all have their own individual timetables.

In the Exam Period Preparation Programme document is the programme for the entire exam period, showing when every exam is and when all the Booster Sessions and additional Revision Sessions take place.



#### Examinations in the morning:

You should arrive at school for 8am and attend the Booster Session. When the Booster Session has finished, you will be expected to go to the room indicated on your individual examination timetable – these will also be displayed each day on the Exam Noticeboard near the Blue corridor. Morning exams will begin at 9am.

#### Examinations in the afternoon:

Y11s will always be first into lunch during the exam period. When you have finished your lunch at 12:40, you will be expected to go straight to your exam.
