## Dear Parent/Carer

Year 10 Mock Exams - $15^{\text {th }}$ to 29 $^{\text {th }}$ June 2023
The Year 10 Mock exams will take place from Thursday $15^{\text {th }}$ June to Thursday 29 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ June 2023. These are important exams as they represent our Year 10 students' first opportunity of sitting exams in their KS4 subjects and will support their preparation for GCSEs next summer. This will also be the first occasion students will have to experience the full procedures for formal exams.

Students must follow the exam expectations, as set out by JCQ, and any students failing to follow the rules will be dealt with seriously.

A copy of the overall exam timetable is attached. Students will be given their individual timetables which tell them the rooms and seating plans for the subjects they take after half term. They should read these carefully to identify when and where the exams in their subjects will take place.

Written exams will take place for most students in the Sports Hall and those students with access arrangements will be given information regarding the rooms and arrangements they will have. Morning exams start at 08.30am and we ask that students are on site and at their exam venue for 08.20am to allow a prompt start.

When students are not in exams they will be in their normal lessons and they should bring the relevant books and equipment for these lessons. When an exam finishes they will also go back to their normal timetabled lesson for the remainder of the session.

It is very important that students bring all the equipment they might need for their exams. This includes black pens, pencils, an eraser and a ruler for the Maths and Science exams. A calculator will also be needed for Science exams and calculator paper in Maths.

We hope that these mock exams will provide students and teachers with information and feedback to work together to ensure every student makes the best progress possible between now and next summer.
