Year 13 Moving on Day - Nottingham Trent University - 13th September 2024

We are delighted to inform you that all Year 13 students in the Redhill Academy Trust will be attending our 'Moving on Day' at the Nottingham Trent University City Campus on Friday 13th September 2024. This is an exciting event as it allows all of the 670 students who will then be in Year 13 across the Trust to come together in one place. This event is in partnership with Nottingham Trent University and a legal education charity called Leducate.

'Moving On Day' involves a series of sessions designed to inform students of essential things they need to know as they move into the next phase of their life as independent adults. These will include topics such as lifetime finances, personal health and consumer/tenant rights. A range of external speakers will be presenting these sessions which will take place in lecture theatres within a small area of the city centre campus. Students will be provided with maps and there will be NTU student helpers around to support them. They should wear their lanyards at all times for easy identification by staff.

Students have been given a choice of four from the following ten sessions:

- Driving and passenger safety - delivered by Via East Midlands
- Cradle to grave finances - delivered by Equifax
- Knowing your rights (consumer and housing rights) - delivered by Leducate
- GP talk on personal health for 18 to 21 year-olds - by GP Dr Rebecca Chellaswamy
- Thriving at University - delivered by Nottingham Trent University
- Revision tips and wellbeing in exams - delivered by Nottingham Trent University
- Understanding student finance - delivered by Nottingham Trent University
- Degree apprenticeships - delivered by Sheffield Hallam University
- Personal and legal safety - delivered by Nottinghamshire Police
- Stand out to Employers and the power of LinkedIn

Students have made their choices via an online Microsoft form in school.

The event is scheduled to commence at 09.30am and conclude at 15.00pm. To ensure a timely arrival for registration, students are required to be present and prepared to board the coach in the school car park by no later than 08.15am. We will depart the university at 15.00pm and estimate arrival back at school, subject to traffic conditions, at approximately 16.30pm. Please note, students who typically utilise the school bus service will need to arrange their own transportation home on this particular day.

We have arranged for students to travel to and from the venue by coach. **This trip cannot be funded without voluntary contributions from parents so we are asking for a contribution towards the cost of transport of £12.00.** Please note that if insufficient voluntary contributions are raised to fund the visit, then the visit will be cancelled. If you wish to make a contribution but have difficulty in doing so, please discuss the matter in confidence with myself or a senior member of staff. Refunds will not be given unless the visit is cancelled by the school.
