Year 10 Work Experience

As part of the Year 10 Personal Development and Careers Programme, Year 10 students have now had information regarding work experience, which is due to take place on Monday 8th July to Friday 12th July 2024.

Students have been asked to think about the type of placement they would like to do and were encouraged to talk about possible work placements with their parents/carers.

Students have had an assembly and have been shown the new placement tool they will be using to arrange and use throughout their placements. The tool is on a platform called UNIFROG – <u>www.unifrog.org.uk</u>. If students have forgotten their password, then please visit <u>www.unifrog.org/sign-in</u> and click on 'forgotten your password'. Here the students will be able to get a reset email sent out to them which will allow them to create a new memorable password and get logged onto the platform. Unifrog uses their school email address.

There is a flowchart to show the new process of applying for placements and explaining the timeline for the application process. Students are expected to do the following regarding placements:

- Contact the companies they are interested in doing their placement in. They will need to have the following information when calling or visiting their chosen company:-
 - Who they are, which school and their year group.
 - Dates of the placement (8th to 12th July 2024)
 - Why they want to go to that company (e.g they want to be a vet, and wish to go to a Veterinary Practice)
- When contacting the placement, the student needs to gain the following information from the Company:
 - Contact name
 - Contact email address
 - Contact phone number
 - Placement name and address including postcode.



Other information students will need to complete on the form on Unifrog:-

- How they will be getting to the placement? (e.g. walking/car)
- Do they have any special needs/illnesses/medical conditions or injuries that may affect their placement?
- Parents/carers name and email

The deadline for students to confirm their placements is **Friday 16th February 2024.** This will give students the best opportunity to secure an early placement.
