

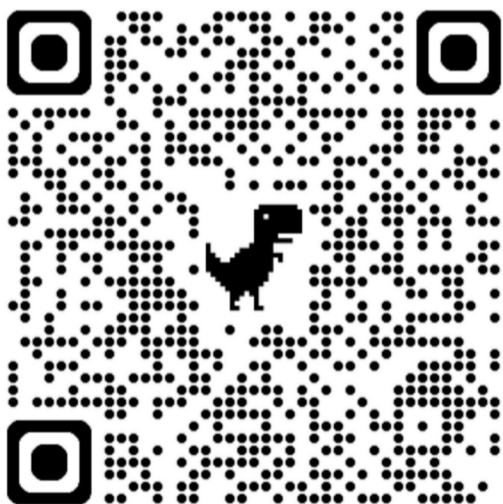
Are you entitled to financial support as a Brookfield Sixth Form Student?

Sixth Form students at Brookfield Sixth Form may be entitled to a Bursary which provides them with financial support if they:

- Live in a household with a total annual household income of £30,000 or less.
- Are in care or are a care leaver.
- Receiving Universal Credit because they are supporting themselves.
- Receiving Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independent Payments.
- Receiving Employment and Support Allowance or Universal Credit.

The Bursary may be used to provide financial support for:

- Stationery pack – including ring binders, paper, pens, pencils, a basic calculator and other common items.
- On-going transport costs – including the purchase of a bus pass.
- Purchasing equipment or resources for identified individual learners – such as specialist protective or course-related equipment.
- Costs of school meals.
- Assistance with costs of educational visits or trips – such as field trips, university interviews and work placements.
- One-off payments linked to specific costs – such as UCAS application fees or travel to university interviews.
